Former Tax Policy Director Returns to the Department of Revenue as Assistant Commissioner

Saint Paul - Acting Commissioner Dan Salomone today announced the appointment of Matt Massman as Assistant Commissioner of Tax Policy for the Minnesota Department of Revenue.

“Matt offers an ideal blend of experience and leadership at a time when Minnesota needs it most,” said Myron Frans, Governor Dayton’s appointee as Commissioner. “He is very talented, and I look forward to working closely with Matt as we move forward in the legislative session.”

For the past six years, Massman has served as lead fiscal analyst for the Minnesota State Senate, advising members on budgetary options in the tax and finance committees. Previously, Massman served as state and local tax policy director for the Department of Revenue. He advised the commissioner on a range of tax policy issues and assisted in developing the department’s analytical capabilities across all tax types.

Massman graduated from Hamline University and received his Master of Arts in public administration from University of Wisconsin-Madison. He spent several years with the Wisconsin Legislative Audit Bureau before accepting a position as fiscal analyst for the Minnesota House.

Massman begins his new duties in mid-January.
