Prior Lake Businessman Facing Felony Tax Charges

St. Paul - The Minnesota Department of Revenue announced today that the Scott County Attorney's Office charged Douglas Nagle, 52, of Eagan, with nine felony tax crimes.

Nagle, owner of Diggers Sales & Service Inc.(doing business as Prior Lake Polaris), is charged with four counts of willful failure to pay Minnesota sales tax, one count of making a sale after the department revoked his sales tax permit, and four counts of willful failure to file corporate tax returns for the 2006 through 2010 tax years.

According to the complaint, Nagle failed to pay sales tax collected for 34 months between June 2008 and October 2011. As of Aug. 3, 2011, Diggers' unpaid sales tax totaled \$608,992. The department revoked Nagle's sales tax permit Oct. 6, 2011. Despite this, he made an illegal sale eight days later, according to the complaint.

The complaint also alleges that Nagle's unpaid corporate income taxes totaled \$5,897, including penalty and interest.

Each felony is punishable by up to five years in prison, up to a \$10,000 fine, or both.

The Minnesota Department of Revenue is dedicated to enforcing tax laws, collecting no more and no less than taxpayers owe. It takes progressively stricter measures against taxpayers who demonstrate they will not voluntarily meet their obligations.
