Statement from Revenue Commissioner Bauerly on the tax administration process after the outcome of 2018 Legislative Session

“Now that we know the outcome of the 2018 Legislative Session, the Minnesota Department of Revenue will begin our process to update the state tax filing systems for taxpayer use in 2019. This process happens annually, starting after the end of the legislative session. This year, we will update the tax filing systems to accommodate the differences between the federal and Minnesota tax laws.”

“We look forward to working together with taxpayers, software vendors, tax preparers and professionals, Volunteer Income Tax Assistance sites, and other stakeholders to ensure everyone has the information, education, and services they need to meet their obligations under Minnesota law.
