New interactive sales tax rate map makes it easier to calculate local sales taxes

ST. PAUL, Minn. – The Minnesota Department of Revenue recently launched a new sales tax rate map designed to help customers calculate the local sales tax for purchases made around the state. The new sales tax rate map is a visual complement to the popular sales tax rate calculator.

“Our customers told us a map would be a helpful tool for determining the tax rate that applies to sales and purchases at specific Minnesota locations,” said Revenue Commissioner Cynthia Bauerly. “We are always looking for ways to make it easier for Minnesotans to meet their tax obligations.
