Analysis of S.F. 217 (Ortman) 1st Engrossment

Effective the day following final enactment.

State agencies and other public entities may collect debts by submitting a claim to the Minnesota Department of Revenue against a refund owed to the debtor. Counties can act as agents for licensed private ambulance services for the purpose of submitting claims to the state for collection of amounts owed.

The bill would disallow the power of counties to act as agents for licensed ambulance services and would allow those ambulance services to submit claims directly to the state. As amended, the bill would also eliminate the provision that allows a county to charge an ambulance service a fee for administering a claim made on its behalf.

The bill would have no revenue impact.
