Analysis of H.F. 910 (Murphy, M.) / S.F. 661 (Bakk)

The city of Hermantown has imposed a local sales tax of 0.5% since 1997. The bill authorizes the city to raise the tax rate to 1% if approved by the voters at a general or special election held before December 31, 2012.

The bill would have no impact on any state fund. Revenue from the rate increase would go to the city of Hermantown for the purposes specified in current law.
