## **EXPLANATION OF THE BILL**

**Current Law:** Under a special law, Beltrami County is authorized to spend up to \$1 per capita for the promotion of tourist, agricultural, and industrial developments.

**Proposed Law:** The proposal would increase the spending limit to \$5 per capita.
