EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

The proposal would increase the city aid base for a defined city by \$220,000 in CY 2005 to 2014. The maximum amount of total aid the city may receive is also increased by \$220,000 in CY 2005 only.

REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL

- The city of Osseo would receive a \$220,000 increase in its city aid base for 2005 to 2014.
- There is no state cost associated with this change in the city aid formula because total aid is set to a fixed appropriation level. The increase in city aid base would shift aid to the city of Osseo and away from other cities receiving local government aid.
