EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

Current Law: The Metropolitan Radio Board has had a sales and use tax exemption for building a public safety radio communication system since August 1, 1997. The current exemption expires on August 1, 2003.

Proposed Law: The bill extends the sunset date two years to August 1, 2005.
