EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

The bill creates a Minneapolis study panel on city governance to study the form and structure of Minneapolis city government and make appropriate recommendations of proposed changes to enhance the quality of life for all citizens of Minneapolis. Appointing authorities shall select seven members to examine the management of the city of Minneapolis and report results and recommendations to the Minneapolis Charter Commission by February 1, 2006.

An appropriation of \$50,000 from the general fund is provided to the city of Minneapolis for funding the study panel. The appropriation shall be deducted from the local government aid payable to Minneapolis in fiscal year 2006.

The language is repealed effective June 30, 2006.

REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL

- There is no net state cost associated with the creation of the Minneapolis city government study panel. The \$50,000 appropriation is deducted from the certified amount of Minneapolis' local government aid in FY 2006.
