EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

The bill provides a procedure for appealing the conclusions of a fiscal note or revenue estimate. The appeal is made by the chair of either the House Committee on Ways and Means or the Senate Committee on Finance, in the case of fiscal notes, or by the chair of either the House Committee on Taxes or the Senate Tax Committee, in the case of revenue estimates. In both cases the appeal is made to the Legislative Commission on Planning and Fiscal Policy.
