EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

The bill authorizes a levy on property located within the area of unorganized territory to which the Morse-Fall Lake Rural First Responder/Fire Protection Association provides first responder services in St. Louis County. The proceeds of the levy are to be distributed to the above association.

REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL

- The size of the levy and number of parcels directly affected are unknown.
- The increase in the property tax could result in a small increase in state-paid homeowner property tax refunds.
