Analysis of S.F. 3111 (Scheid) / H.F. 3440 (Dittrich)

The bill would allow property tax payments to be paid by electronic means. Counties would be authorized to impose a charge for any dishonored electronic payments, and all charges for dishonored payments of property taxes would become a lien on the property in the same manner as fines, forfeitures, and penalties.

The proposal would become effective beginning with property taxes payable in 2011.

The bill would have no impact on state revenues.
