Analysis of S.F. 1968 (Pederson) / H.F. 2535 (O'Driscoll)

The 0.5% St. Cloud area sales and use tax is imposed in the cities of St. Cloud, Sartell, Sauk Rapids, St. Augusta, St. Joseph, and Waite Park. The tax proceeds are used to fund a number of local projects. Currently the tax expires no later than December 31, 2018.

The bill authorizes the tax proceeds to be used for additional purposes and provides that, if approved by the voters, the tax may be extended through December 31, 2038.

The bill would have no impact on any state fund.
