Analysis of H.F. 905 (Murphy, M.) / S.F. 795 (Bakk)

The city of Proctor has imposed a general sales and use tax of 0.5% since April 1, 2000.

The bill authorizes the city of Proctor to impose an additional sales and use tax of up to 0.5% if it is approved by the voters at the next general election. The bill also authorizes the city to approve retroactively changes in the use of the tax revenue that the Legislature authorized in 2008 and 2010.

The bill would have no impact on any state fund. Proceeds from the tax would be used for the purposes specified.
