Analysis of H.F. 1417 (Hamilton) / S.F. 1207 (Weber)

The bill authorizes the city of Windom to impose a general sales and use tax of up to 1% and an excise tax of \$20 per motor vehicle sold by dealers in the city. The taxes must be approved by the voters at an election held on or before November 4, 2014.

The bill would have no impact on any state fund. Proceeds from the tax would be used for the purposes specified in the bill.
