Department of Revenue Analysis of S.F. 1883 (Relph) As Proposed to be Amended (SCS1883A-2)

The city of St. Cloud imposes a 1% tax on on-sale liquor and food and beverages. The city also imposes a 5% lodging tax. The bill allows the city of St. Cloud to increase the tax on on-sale liquor and food and beverages up to 0.5% and the lodging tax up to 1%, if approved by voters at a general election.

The proceeds of the increased taxes are for remodeling, improvements, and expansion of the Municipal Athletic Center, including bond payments.

The bill has no impact on any state fund.
