What is on the agenda for the 2018 Fall Forum?

The 2018 Fall Forum will include **presentations** from the MN Public Utilities Commission, MN Department of Commerce (Division of Energy Resources), and updates from the MN Department of Revenue.

There will be a **panel discussion** on the topic of parcel ID assignments, property reporting/tracking, and deeds. This panel will include a County Auditor, County Assessor, County Recorder, PRISM representative, and a Company Representative.

Following the presentations and panel discussion, the department will facilitate **industry break-out sessions**, where all attendees are welcome to participate in group discussions segmented by the following industries: pipeline, utility (gas & electric), railroad.

The event will conclude with a **call back to the forum**.

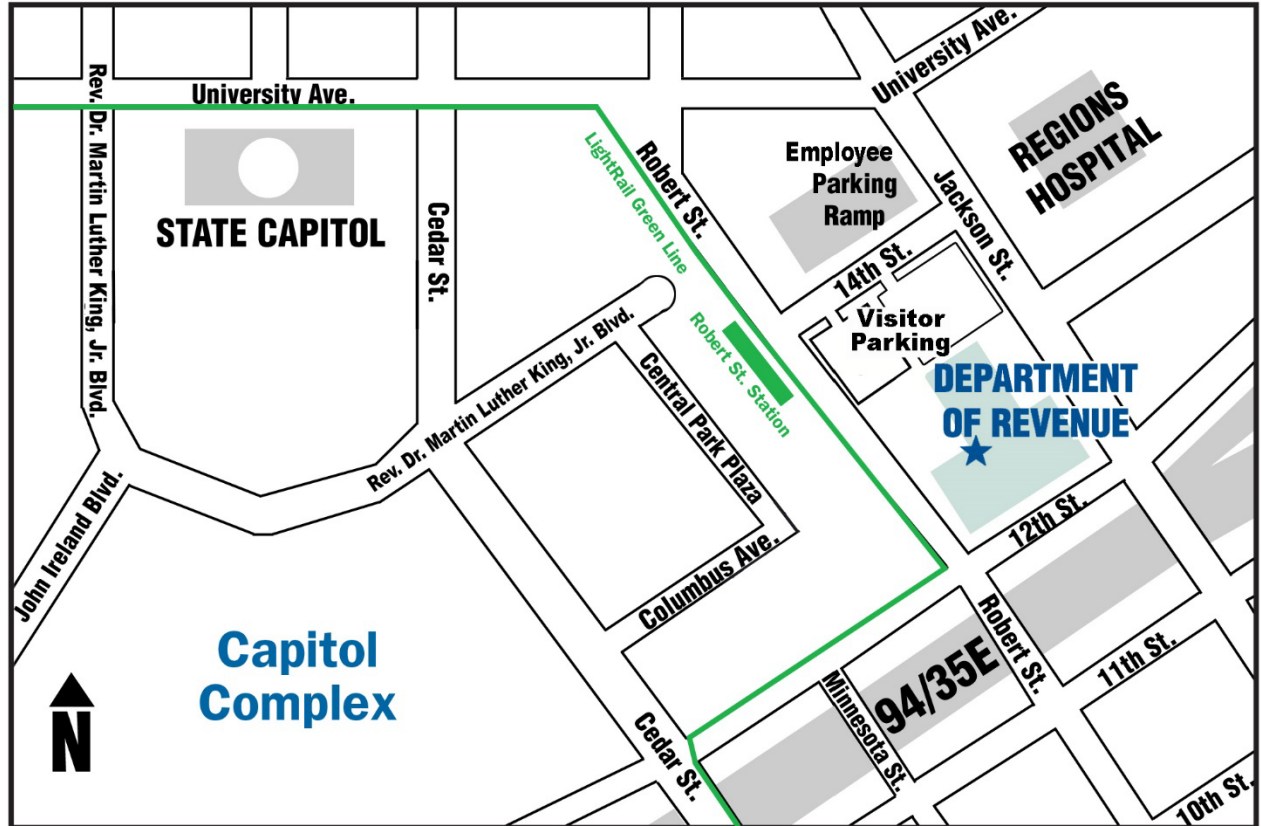
Do you have discussion question suggestions?
