

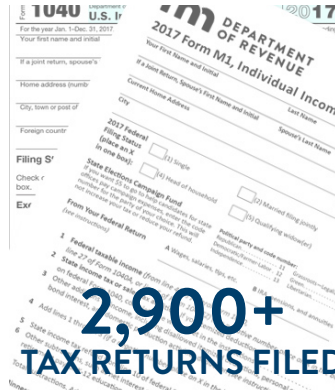
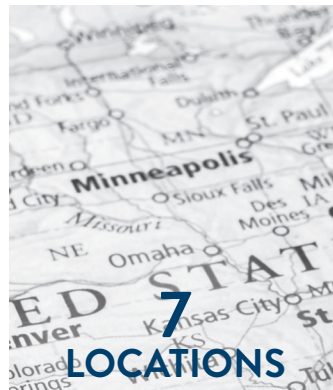


VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

Make a difference in people's lives by volunteering for the Minnesota Department of Revenue's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program! You will provide tax assistance to people with disabilities, low-income, limited English-speaking abilities, and age 60 or older. We need volunteers beginning February 1 through the end of the filing season.

Why volunteer with VITA?

- **Learn about taxes** and gain valuable work experience while serving your community.
- **Meet and interact** with people from different backgrounds and cultures.
- **Receive free training** to become an IRS-certified income tax preparer for Minnesota families.



What volunteer opportunities are available?

- Tax return preparers
- Quality reviewers
- Administrative assistants
- Language interpreters (Spanish, Somali, Hmong, Oromo, Amharic, Karen, etc.)

You will attend free training in January and are expected to provide three to four hours of service each week during the filing season. Some VITA sites are open during the day while others are open evenings and weekends. You can find a site to fit your schedule!
