**MINNEAPOLIS - SAINT PAUL AREA** -- Anoka, Carver, Chisago, Dakota, Hennepin, Isanti, Ramsey, Scott, Washington, and Wright. For the 2014 report there are less than four businesses reporting in the Minneapolis - Saint Paul Area and these businesses are distributed to other regions. The re-distribution is intended to be equitable and to create minimal distortions.

**NORTHWEST MINNESOTA** -- Becker, Beltrami, Cass, Clay, Clearwater, Hubbard, Kittson, Lake of the Woods, Mahnommen, Marshall, Norman, Pennington, Polk, Red Lake, Roseau, and Wilkin.

**SOUTHERN MINNESOTA** -- Big Stone, Blue Earth, Brown, Chippewa, Cottonwood, Dodge, Faribault, Fillmore, Freeborn, Goodhue, Houston, Jackson, Lac qui Parle, Le Sueur, Lincoln, Lyon, Martin, Mower, Murray, Nicollet, Nobles, Olmsted, Pipestone, Redwood, Renville, Rice, Rock, Sibley, Steele, Swift, Traverse, Wabasha, Waseca, Watonwan, Winona, and Yellow Medicine.

**NORTHEAST MINNESOTA** -- Carlton, Cook, Itasca, Kanabec, Koochiching, Lake, Pine, and St. Louis.
