Purpose of This Form

By signing this form, you direct the Minnesota Department of Revenue to revoke authority for the appointees listed above. The appointee will no longer be able to represent the taxpayer or receive their private information.

Appointees can be reinstated using Form REV184i, *Individual or Sole Proprietor Power of Attorney* or Form REV184b, *Business Power of Attorney*.

Your Signature

This revocation is not valid until it is signed and dated by someone with legal authority to sign it. For most people, this is the taxpayer whose information is being shared.
