Analysis of H.F. 2956 (Lueck) / S.F. 2992 (Ruud)

The bill authorizes the city of Crosslake to impose a sales and use tax of up to 0.5%. The proceeds would be used to finance capital and administrative costs for modifications to a bio-solids treatment facility and sewer service expansions.

The bill authorizes a bond issuance of up to \$4.8 million plus bond costs. The tax would terminate at the earlier of 15 years after it is first imposed or when the city council determines that sufficient funds have been received to pay for the costs of the bonds. The tax may expire earlier if the city so determines by ordinance.

The bill would have no impact on state taxes.
