The bill authorizes the city of Northfield to impose a sales and use tax of 0.5%, if approved by the voters at a general election. The proceeds would be used to finance the construction, reconstruction, and capital improvements to certain regional parks, trails, and open spaces.

The bill authorizes a bond issuance of up to \$13 million plus bond costs. The tax would expire at the earlier of 20 years after it is first imposed or when the city council determines that sufficient funds have been received to pay for the costs of the bonds. The tax may expire earlier if the city so determines by ordinance.

The bill would have no impact on state taxes.
