

## **Adoption of Rule Changes for Assessor Education and Licensing**

Changes were made to the rules pertaining to the State Board of Assessors licensing and education requirements. These changes took effect beginning August 3, 2020.

### **AMA Requirements:**

- Removed assessment administration course
- Removed the 30-hour elective course requirement
- Removed the 15-hour USPAP requirement
- Added a 15-hour property type specific course

### **SAMA Requirements:**

- Added assessment administration course
- Added management and leadership courses with a minimum of 30 hours

### **Reinstatement Requirements:**

- Removed the seven-hour USPAP update course for a former licensee seeking reinstatement

### **Continuing Education Minimum Hour Requirement:**

- Removed the three-hour minimum requirement
- Added a one-hour minimum requirement

### **Jurisdiction License Levels:**

- Eliminated the list that designated the level of assessor licensure necessary for each jurisdiction

### **Designation:**

- Allowing the IAAO designation of MAS (mass appraisal specialist) to be used as a substitute for a narrative appraisal for obtaining AMA licensure.

### **Temporary License:**

- Updated the expiration period from four to five years for a temporary license holder to obtain an AMA license.
