

If you are a contractor who works on a project for the state of Minnesota or any of its local government subdivisions such as a county, city or school district — you will need a certified Contractor Affidavit from the Minnesota Department of Revenue before you will receive your final payment.

## How do I get a certified Contractor Affidavit? It's as easy as 1 – 2 – 3!

- 1. File and pay your Minnesota withholding tax.
- 2. Complete a Contractor Affidavit when your work on the project is done.
- 3. Submit all Contractor Affidavits to the Minnesota Department of Revenue.

If you complete your Contractor Affidavit electronically, you will receive immediate notification.

**Note:** If you are a prime contractor, you must collect a certified Contractor Affidavit from each of your subcontractors. Do not give them their final payment until you receive their certified Contractor Affidavit.

## What you should know

If you hire or contract with a non-Minnesota contractor to perform construction work in Minnesota, you must withhold 8 percent of their compensation as a Minnesota surety deposit. For details, see Withholding Tax Fact Sheet 12, *Surety Deposits for Non-Minnesota Construction Contractors*.
