Department of Revenue Analysis of H.F. 693 (Igo)

The bill authorizes the city of Grand Rapids to impose a sales and use tax of 1.0%, if approved by the voters at a general election. The proceeds would be used to finance capital and administrative costs for the reconstruction and remodeling of the Grand Rapids IRA Civic Center.

The bill authorizes a bond issuance of up to \$10.98 million plus bond costs. The tax would terminate when the city council determines that sufficient funds have been received to pay for the costs of the bonds. The tax may expire earlier if the city so determines by ordinance.

The bill would have no impact on state taxes.
