Analysis of S.F. 1297 (Ingebrigtsen) As Proposed to be Amended (SCS1297A-1)

The bill authorizes the city of Fergus Falls to impose a sales and use tax of 0.5%, if approved by the voters at a general election. The tax would be in addition to the existing 0.5% local sales and use tax that was imposed in 2018. The proceeds would be used to finance \$7.8 million for an aquatics center and \$5.2 million for the DeLagoon Improvement Project.

The bill authorizes a bond issuance of up to \$13 million plus bond costs. The tax would terminate at the earlier of December 1, 2039, or when the city council determines that sufficient funds have been received to pay for the costs of the projects and bonds. The tax may expire earlier if the city so determines by ordinance.

The bill would have no impact on state taxes.
