EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

The proposal would create community career workforce academies. These public-private partnerships would help train students and adults for high skilled jobs. Counites could apply for grants through the Minnesota Employment and Economic Development. A total of \$40 million would be appropriated from the general fund in FY2023 for these grants, with \$10 million of the total earmarked for an academy in Moorhead.
