## **EXPLANATION OF THE BILL**

The bill provides an exemption from the sales and use tax for materials, supplies, and equipment used in the construction of the St. Joseph's Jacob Wetterling Community Center. The exemption applies to purchases made after September 1, 2022, and before January 1, 2025. The exemption would be administered as a refund.

## **REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL**

- Information for the estimates was provided by a representative of the city of St. Joseph.
- It is estimated that construction costs for the community center will total \$18 million.
- It is estimated that taxable materials and supplies will total \$7.2 million.
