EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

Current Law: The solid waste management tax (SWMT) is imposed on charges for the collection and disposal of solid waste. Seventy percent of the revenues are dedicated to the Environmental Fund with the remainder deposited in the General Fund.

Proposed Law: The following amounts will be deposited into the environmental fund in addition to the 70% allocation to the Environmental fund for specified purposes in the following manner:

- a. In fiscal year 2024, ten percent of the amount generated from solid waste management tax
- b. In fiscal year 2025, twenty percent of the amount generated from solid waste management tax
- c. In fiscal year 2026 and later, thirty percent of the amount generated from solid waste management tax

REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL

- Solid waste Management Tax collections from the February 2023 forecast are used to estimate the transfers
- The estimates reflect the difference between the current law transfer amount and the proposed transfer.
