


Save your receipts!

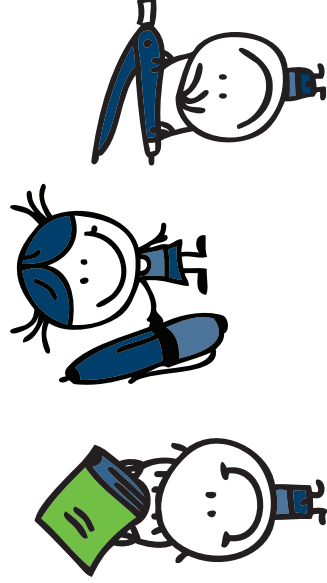
