### **Requirements for Continuing Education: (Course/Seminar)**

- Subject must apply to assessment or appraisal
- Course/Seminar must be a minimum of 1 hour in length Note: one-hour seminars require a specific sponsoring organization, see the <u>board's continuing education policy</u>.
- Course/Seminar must apply to assessors in general and not to a specific CAMA/tax system or taxing jurisdiction.
- Course/Seminar must be available and marketed to an entire region, at minimum.

### **Requirements for Licensure Course:**

- Course must be a minimum of 15 hours in length
- Course must offer an exam, specify allowed timeframe for exam
  - This requirement does not apply to management & leadership courses
- Course submitted for approval as an alternate to a required course must be similar to the required course

Please submit request at least 60 days before course/seminar attendance date to ensure the board can act on your request before the course/seminar is attended.
