# Minnesota Homeowners with Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITINs):



### You now qualify for the Homestead Credit Refund!

Are you a homeowner with an ITIN instead of a Social Security Number?

Starting this year, you may qualify for homestead status for your residence and claim a refund on Form M1PR, Homestead Credit Refund (for Homeowners) and Renter's Property Tax Refund.

This is a great opportunity to maximize your tax benefits and save on your property taxes.

#### How can I qualify for this refund?

For the 2022 Homestead Credit Refund, your property must be homesteaded with your county by December 31, 2023.

- Check your 2023 Statement of Property Taxes Payable. If your property is not classified as a homestead on this statement, contact your county assessor's office and apply for homestead status by December 31. Note: If you are a mobile homeowner applying for the 2022 refund, you must have applied for and received homestead classification by May 29, 2023.
- You owned and lived in your home on January 2, 2023. If you purchased your home in 2022
  and it is not classified as a homestead, apply for homestead status with your county assessor's
  office by December 31.
- When applying for homestead status, request a signed statement from your county assessor's office confirming your approval. Include this statement when filing for the refund.

#### How do I apply?

Go to www.revenue.state.mn.us and enter homeowner's refund into the Search box. You may file electronically through our website or print and file Form M1PR by mail.

## Minnesota Property Tax Refund

#### Minnesota has two property tax refund programs that may be for you!

- Regular property tax refund
   This refund is available for homeowners and renters with either a Social Security
   Number or an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).

   Visit our website at www.revenue.state.mn.us to see if you qualify!
- Special property tax refund (for homeowners)
   If you are a homeowner, you may qualify if your property taxes this year were at least 12% (6% for 2022) higher than last year and you owned and lived in your home on January 2 of each year. The increase must be at least \$100. There is no income limit.
