Did you rent last year? Claim a refund for paying your rent!



You may qualify for a tax refund if your household income is less than \$73,270. You can qualify even if all of the income earned on your reservation is exempt from Minnesota income tax. Some unique situations may affect eligibility and refund amounts.

What do I need to claim the refund?

- A completed Form M1PR, Homestead Credit Refund (for Homeowners) and Renter's Property Tax Refund.
- A copy of your Certificate of Rent Paid (CRP).
 - Your landlord must provide you a CRP no later than January 31, 2024.
 - You will receive one CRP for each unit you rented during the calendar year.
 Note: Your refund may be delayed or denied if you do not include CRPs.

How do I file for the refund?

- Electronically: Use a tax software to prepare or submit Form M1PR. Software fees may apply.
- By mail: Go to www.revenue.state.mn.us to download and complete Form M1PR. Mail in your completed return and copies of all CRPs you received.

When do I need to file?

File for the 2023 Renter's Property Tax Refund before it expires on **August 15, 2025**. Common Questions for the Renter's Property Tax Refund

Do I still qualify if my rental unit is on trust land?

No, because trust land is exempt from Minnesota property tax. You may still qualify if your rental unit is on fee land. If you are unsure if your unit is on trust land or fee land, contact your county assessor's office.

What if I did not get a Certificate of Rent Paid (CRP) from my landlord by January 31?

Contact your landlord or property manager to have the CRP issued.

What is my CRP is missing or has incorrect information?

Contact your landlord or property manager to have it issued or corrected. If you do not have a correct CRP by March 1, call us at 651-296-3781 or 1-800-652-9094.

We may be able to send you a Rent Paid Affidavit to use in place of a CRP. You would need to file Form M1PR by mail and include proof of your rent payments.
