

CMA Requirements List

Courses

- Minnesota Assessment Laws & Procedures
 Note: Must have been taken within the previous five years for an initial license.
- □ Residential Appraisal Principles
- □ Residential Appraisal Procedures
- □ Mass Appraisal Basics

Assessment Experience

- □ One year (12 full months) of assessment experience
- Employment Verification Letter signed by a licensed Supervisor or County Assessor
- Trainee Exposure Check List
 Note: Review the board's <u>experience policies</u> for more details

Application & Fee

- Once all of the above requirements are completed, submit a CMA application and pay the application fee on the <u>Assessors Licensing System</u>.
- Note:
 - The Board does not act on applications until **ALL** requirements have been met.
 - CMA applications that have met the required licensing requirements and fees will be processed by the board's Administrator. A board meeting is no longer required to process these types of applications.

Equivalent Assessor Education
