

Minnesota Homeowners with Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITINs):



You may qualify for the Homestead Credit Refund!

Are you a homeowner with an ITIN instead of a Social Security Number?

You may qualify for homestead status for your residence and claim a refund on Form M1PR, *Homestead Credit Refund*.

This is a great opportunity to maximize your tax benefits and save on your property taxes.

How can I qualify for this refund?

- **Check your current year Statement of Property Taxes Payable.** If your property is not classified as a homestead on this statement, contact your county assessor's office and apply for homestead status by December 31. **Note:** If you are a mobile homeowner applying for this refund, you must have applied for and received homestead classification by May 29.
- **You owned and lived in your home on January 2.** If you purchased your home in the past year and it is not classified as a homestead, apply for homestead status with your county assessor's office by December 31.
- **When applying for homestead status,** request a signed statement from your county assessor's office confirming your approval. Include this statement when filing for the refund.

How do I apply?

Go to www.revenue.state.mn.us and enter **homeowner's refund** into the Search box. You can file electronically through our website or print and file Form M1PR by mail.

Minnesota Property Tax Refund

Minnesota has two property tax refund programs that may be for you!

- **Regular property tax refund**

This refund is available for **homeowners with either a Social Security Number or an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)**.

Visit our website at www.revenue.state.mn.us to see if you qualify!

- **Special property tax refund**

If you are a homeowner, you may qualify if your property taxes this year were at least 12% higher than last year and you owned and lived in your home on January 2 of each year. The increase must be at least \$100. There is no income limit.
