



Minnesota Working Family Credit: Working for you!



The Working Family Credit delivers tax relief to individuals whose income is below a certain level. The credit can reduce the tax you owe and provide you with a tax refund.

Am I eligible for the Working Family Credit?

Generally, you must meet these requirements to claim the Working Family Credit.

- You were a full-year or part-year resident of Minnesota in 2025 (with certain exceptions for military members).
- You are not a dependent of another person.
- If you are married and you or your spouse are a nonresident alien, your filing status must be Married Filing Jointly.
- If you have no qualifying children, you and your spouse must have resided in the U.S. for more than half of 2025.

As a Tribal member, you may qualify for the credit and receive a refund, even if Minnesota does not tax you on your income because you live and work on your home reservation.

How much is it?

The Working Family Credit is 4% of your earned income up to \$379. The credit is phased out if your income is over \$37,910 for Married Filing Jointly or over \$31,950 for other filers.

How do I claim it?

Claim the Working Family Credit using Schedule M1CWFC, *Minnesota Child and Working Family Credits* when filing Form M1, *Individual Income Tax Return*.
