Analysis of H.F. 3370 (Rehrauer) /S.F. 4269 (Hoffman)

The bill authorizes, if approved by the voters at a general election, the city of Coon Rapids to impose a sales and use tax of up to 0.5%.

The proceeds of \$40 million would be used to finance the renovation and expansion of the police department and city center facility, including the city hall and civic center and another \$40 million for the construction of a new community center and expansion of the Coon Rapids Ice Center. The bill also authorizes a bond issuance of up to \$80 million plus bond costs.

The tax would terminate at the earlier of 25 years from when first imposed or when the city council determines that \$80 million has been received from the tax to pay for the costs of the project listed above. The tax could expire earlier if the city so determines by ordinance.

The bill would have no impact on state taxes.
