EXPLANATION OF THE BILL

Current Law: Tickets and admissions to games, events, and activities sponsored by the Minnesota State High School League are exempt from the sales tax. The current exemption is effective for sales and purchases made after June 30, 2017, and before July 1, 2027.

Proposed Law: The bill, as proposed to be amended, would extend the exemption until July 1, 2035.

REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL

- The estimates are based on information provided by the Minnesota State High School League.
- The estimates assume an increase of 4.8% annually based on historical growth in the exemption.
